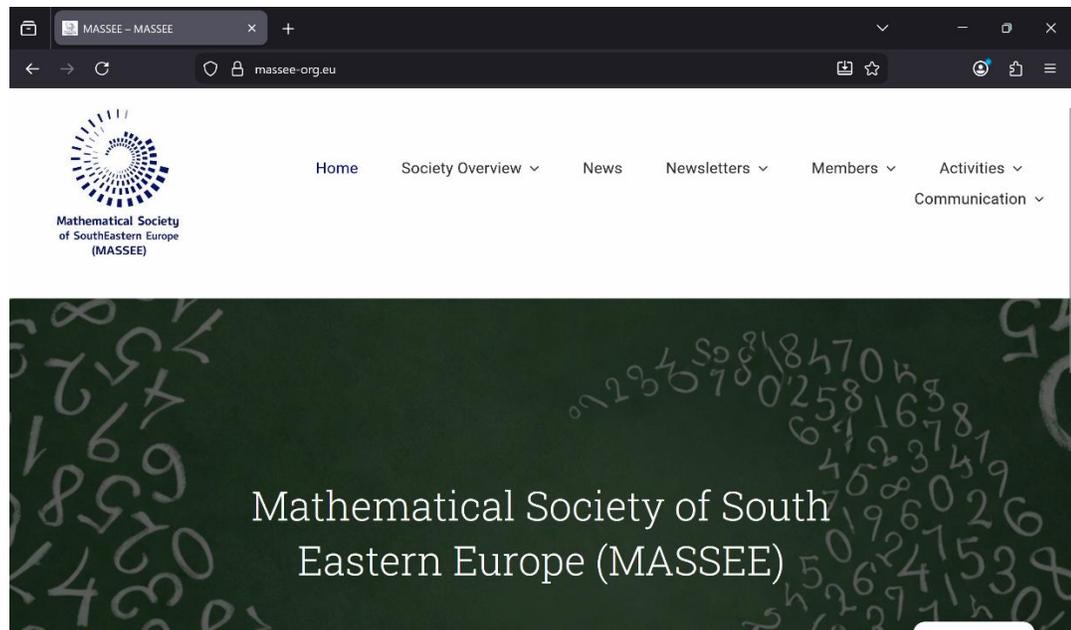
## WELCOME TO THE NEW MASSEE WEBSITE !

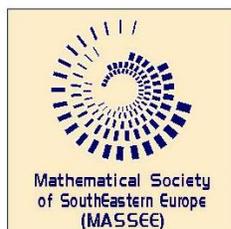

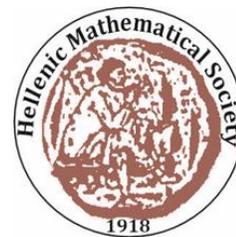

June 29 – July 4, 2026, Athens, Greece

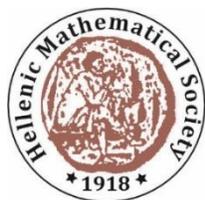
- National and Kapodistrian University of Athens in the building of the Department of Mathematics and

### Analysis for Undergraduate and Graduate Students Nesin Mathematics Village, Izmir, 12 – 18 January 2026

The intensive [Winter program on Analysis for Undergraduate and Graduate Students](#) and is designed to reinforce the foundations of mathematical analysis for undergraduate and graduate students. The curriculum offers a diverse range of courses including the axioms of real numbers, fundamental inequalities, introduction to topology, series, and abstract measure theory. Aimed at fostering mathematical maturity, the camp provides a rigorous environment where students engage with core concepts and advanced theories under the guidance of experienced mathematicians, ensuring a solid transition to higher-level mathematical research.



### Arithmetic Winter Camp

Nesin Mathematics Village, Izmir, 2 – 6 February 2026

The [Arithmetic Winter Camp](#) is a specialized winter school tailored for advanced undergraduate and graduate student, with the focus on the core intersections of number theory and algebraic geometry. The curriculum provides an in-depth introduction to algebraic function fields, algebraic curves, and the pivotal Riemann-Roch Theorem. Through a structured program of theoretical lectures and collaborative problem-solving sessions, participants will explore valuations, divisors, and rational functions. The camp aims to equip students with the necessary tools for advanced research in arithmetic and geometry while fostering a cooperative learning environment.
